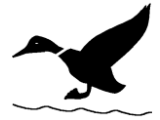

Code of Conduct

The Rushmoor Mallards Club is a charity that aims to provide a range of sporting and recreational activities that are suitable for people of all ages that have any form of disability.

The Club also welcomes the disabled member's friends and family.

This document details the Code of Conduct of the Club and must be followed by all Club members.

Where a Club member is accompanied by a non-member whilst undertaking a Club activity, it is the member's responsibility to ensure that the non-member is aware of, and follows, the rules that are set out in this document.

The Rushmoor Mallards Club is supported by several other organisations (such as Farnborough Leisure Centre, the Lions and Rotary clubs etc). These clubs may have additional codes of conduct that duplicate or enhance the rules laid out in this document.

The following rules are mandatory whilst conducting any activity that is related to the club. Violation of any of these rules will be dealt with quickly and, if possible, immediately on detection. The action taken will be in accordance with the Club's Disciplinary Procedures (which are available on request).

- 1 No behaviour is permitted that could cause harm to oneself or others
- 2 Respect must be given to other members, sports facilities and associated equipment, staff and any helpers
- 3 No anti-social behaviour, bullying or harassment is permitted
- 4 No swearing or abusive language is permitted
- 5 Cheating is not permitted
- 6 It is forbidden to participate in any Club sporting activities whilst under the influence of drink, drugs or any other intoxicating substance. Consumption of responsible amounts of alcohol may be permitted at certain (non-sports) social events
- 7 The coach/sports leader should be advised of anything that prevents you from taking part in any activity

Terms of Membership

- 1 Members who leave the club's designated areas are no longer covered by the club's policies and protection
- 2 Membership cards are to be shown as and when required
- 3 Members are required to pay any required fees
